

HARDSHIP PRACTICE ENHANCEMENT GRANT: Value: Up to \$3,000

The purpose of this grant is to support enrolled nurses, registered nurses and/or midwives who are experiencing personal or financial hardship to undertake activities that will enhance and develop innovative approaches to nursing and/or midwifery practice. Eligible activities include postgraduate studies, small clinically based projects, mentoring in clinical practice or professional education including small modules or seminars. Areas of hardship can include: financial hardship – be receiving a means-tested Centrelink benefit or can demonstrate personal or family taxable income below the HELP repayment threshold, depending on independence status and or disability/long term medical condition. *Successful applicants will be required to submit confirmation of hardship prior to funds being released.*

LEADERSHIP GRANT: MENTAL HEALTH Value: Up to \$10,000

The purpose of the 2018 leadership grant is to support emerging and existing leaders from nursing and/or midwifery to undertake further studies in leadership development. Applicants must be living in Victoria and currently working within Mental Health. Eligible activities include postgraduate studies specific to leadership development.

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2018 NBVLL Grants and Fellowships

MONA MENZIES POSTDOCTORAL RESEARCH GRANT:

Value: Up to \$50,000:

The purpose of this grant is to facilitate *postdoctoral* research that relates to improving health outcomes across a number of areas, and/or changing the scope of practice in nursing and midwifery. Registered nurses and/or midwives with a doctoral qualification who propose to conduct research will be considered, provided the research is related to the Victorian public. *Grants are not available for research projects undertaken as part of studies towards an academic award.*

ELLA LOWE GRANT

Value: Up to \$50,000:

The purpose of this grant is to facilitate research, education or program evaluation in any clinical setting that has the potential to lead to better patient outcomes. This grant is available to any registered nurse and/or midwife who is registered with the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia who proposes to conduct activities as outlined above. *Grants are not available for research projects undertaken as part of studies toward an academic award.*

MAJOR RESEARCH GRANT:

Value: Up to \$20,000

The purpose of this grant is to facilitate research that relates to improving health outcomes across a number of areas, and/or changing the scope of practice in nursing and midwifery. This grant is available to any registered nurse and/or midwife registered with the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia who proposes to conduct research as outlined above. *Grants are not available for research projects undertaken as part of studies toward an academic award.*

ROSEMARY KELLEY RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP:

Value: Up to \$20,000

The purpose of the Rosemary Kelley Fellowships is to support registered nurses undertaking research to advance knowledge and skills in haematological malignancies (leukaemias, lymphomas, myeloma and related blood disorders) and other forms of cancer. *Grants are not available for research projects undertaken as part of studies towards an academic award.*

ROSEMARY KELLEY TRUST:

Value: Professional Development— up to \$3,000

Value: Postgraduate Nursing Course— up to \$5,000

The purpose of the Rosemary Kelley Fellowships is to support registered nurses in Victoria undertaking activities to advance their knowledge and skills in haematological malignancies (leukaemias, lymphomas, myeloma and related blood disorders) and other forms of cancer.

ENROLLED NURSE PRACTICE ENHANCEMENT GRANTS: Value: Up to \$3,000

The purpose of this grant is to enable enrolled nurses who are directly or indirectly involved in clinical practice in any clinical setting, to undertake activities that will enhance and develop innovative approaches to nursing practice. Enhancements may include changes to practice and policy development. Eligible activities may include small clinically based projects, mentoring in clinical practice or professional education including small modules or seminars. *Funding is not available for education leading to an award e.g. postgraduate qualification.*

MARJORY TAYLOR FELLOWSHIP:

Value: Up to \$3,000

The purpose of this fellowship is to support registered nurses and/or registered midwives whose primary place of practice is in the Barwon region of Victoria in their efforts to undertake nursing and midwifery education (courses or professional development), to advance their knowledge and skills in their particular field, or undertake research relating to nursing and midwifery.

WILLIAM COOPER FELLOWSHIP

Value: Up to \$3,000

The purpose of this fellowship is to enable registered nurses who are directly or indirectly involved with caring for patients with cancer in Victoria to undertake activities that will enhance nursing practice. The Fellowships will be awarded to assist the development of

innovative approaches to enhancing nursing practice. Eligible activities may include projects for changing clinical practice, mentoring in clinical practice or professional education including small modules or seminars. *Funding is not available for education leading to an award e.g. postgraduate qualification.*

JUNE ALLEN PRACTICE ENHANCEMENT GRANT: Value: Up to \$3,000

The purpose of this grant is to enable registered nurses and/or registered midwives who are directly or indirectly involved in clinical practice in any clinical setting to undertake activities that will enhance and develop innovative approaches to nursing and midwifery practice. Eligible activities may include small clinically based projects, mentoring in clinical practice or professional education including small modules or seminars. *Funding is not available for education leading to an award e.g. postgraduate Qualification*

ABORIGINAL PRACTICE ENHANCEMENT GRANT : Value: Up to \$3,000

The purpose of this grant is to enable enrolled nurses, registered nurses and/or registered midwives who identify as Aboriginal, living and working in Victoria, to undertake activities that will enhance and develop innovative approaches to nursing and/or midwifery practice. Eligible activities include postgraduate studies, small clinically based projects, mentoring in clinical practice or professional education including small modules or seminars

RURAL OR REGIONAL PRACTICE ENHANCEMENT GRANTS: Value: Up to \$5,000

The purpose of this grant is to enable enrolled nurses, registered nurses and/or midwives who live and work in rural or regional areas to undertake activities that will enhance and develop innovative approaches to rural/regional nursing practice. Eligible activities include postgraduate studies, small clinically based projects, mentoring in clinical practice or professional education including small modules or seminars. *Please refer to the NBVLL website for eligibility of rural/regional services. Successful applicants will be required to submit confirmation of rural/regional permanency of work and living*
